* **Information Requests:** They include the completion of detailed medical & social histories, summaries of time spent in care, information requests that involve receipt of Ministerial consent, requests from lawyers, public trustees, social workers and questions & requests of a general nature which don't fit into other categories.

** **Treaty Status:** The Post Adoption Registry provides information to Indian & Northern Affairs in order for them to determine treaty status for adoptees. The information is obtained by reviewing the adoption records.

*** **Picture Exchange:** The Registry facilitates the exchange of pictures and letters between birth and adoptive families.

Detailed Medical/ Social history:

A detailed medical / social history is a written summary of an individual(s) medical history that is retained in the sealed adoption file or child welfare documents.

Summary of Time in Care (TIC):

A summary of time in care is a written summary of an adopted person's time in care prior to adoption.

Post Guardianship Request (PGS):

Is a request from previous ward that wish to obtain specific information from the file.
